Maximilian Steinhardt, MD was born in Augsburg, Germany. He worked as a paramedic and studied medicine at Göttingen university, one of Europe's oldest and most renowned public universities, founded in 1737. There, he researched macrophages for his PhD thesis. He was accepted as scholar of the German National Academic Foundation and continued his research at NYU in 2011. Max completed his german 6-year oncology residency in Würzburg, where he specialized and published in Multiple Myeloma and paraproteinemic disorders. Since 2022, he is an integral part of Würzburg's amyloidosis and myeloma center for treatment and translational research.
